Going into downtown Washington is a simple matter of riding the metro; and the hotel shuttle will take you to the closest Metro station, in addition to shops and restaurants within a three mile radius of the hotel, including the Air and Space Museum.

On our list of important sites are: Mount Vernon, Vint Hill Winery, Manassas Battlefield, various memorials and culminating at the National Museum of the United States Army, one of the most unique museums you will ever visit.

Reunion Cancellation Policies

Between 15 and 29 days the Association will refund 75% of fees provided written notice is received. If notice is received in 14 days or less, no refund will be made except in those cases where injury/illness prohibited attendance and then any refund will be on a case by case basis depending on any losses due to the cancellation, such as monies already paid to tour operators, hotels

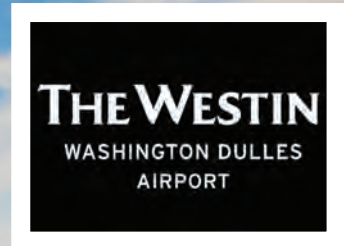



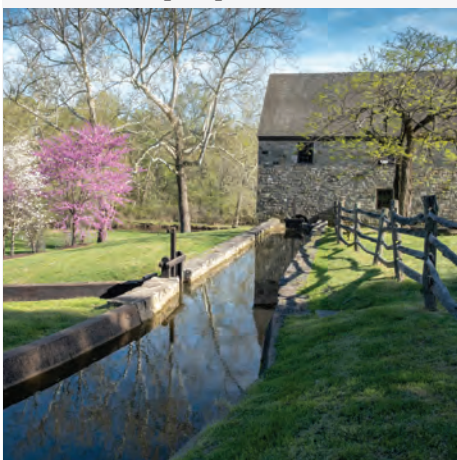
Tuesday, October 1: Mount Vernon

Our sightseeing coach departs to **George Washington's Mount Vernon** where we will enjoy a guided tour before lunch (at your own expense) at the cafe.



After lunch we will continue our tour of the Virginia countryside with a visit to **George Washington's Gristmill** (time permitting) before returning to the hotel at approximately 4:00 pm.

Wednesday, October 2: Manassas Battlefield Park

Our tour to the **Manassas Battlefield Park** departs. Manassas, also known as Bull Run is the site of two major American Civil War battles. The first battle, July 21, 1861, was a Confederate victory that made both sides realize the Civil War was going to last longer than anyone thought.



Our tour continues to the **Vint Hill Craft Winery** – where our military intercepted the German Encryption codes that started the end of World War II and our own National Security Agency (NSA).



We will enjoy a wine tasting before returning to the hotel about 4:00 pm.

Thursday, October 3: Washington, DC

Today is the day we will visit our nation's capital. Our **Washington, DC** guided tour will view the White House and US Capitol buildings (outside) before continuing on our Memorial tour.



We will see the World War II Memorial, Thomas Jefferson Memorial, Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, and the Vietnam Women's Memorial before stopping at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial where we will lay a wreath to the fallen. The coach will return to the hotel about 4:00 pm.

Friday, October 4: National Museum of the United States Army

An exciting day is in store for us when we visit the **National Museum of the United States Army** including a box lunch. This museum depicts the US Army from a Soldier's perspective. The exhibits include the Army's role in our history from the founding of our country (Revolutionary War) up to and including the Global War on Terror. In between there was the Civil War, WWI and WWII and the Cold War including the Army's role in our society and the brand new D-Day Exhibit in honor of the 80th anniversary of the D-Day Landings. Other interesting exhibits include soldiers' stories, the Medal of Honor experience and more. We will return to the hotel in time to relax a bit before our evening activity.
