*The Alohilani Resort fee covers the items listed below.

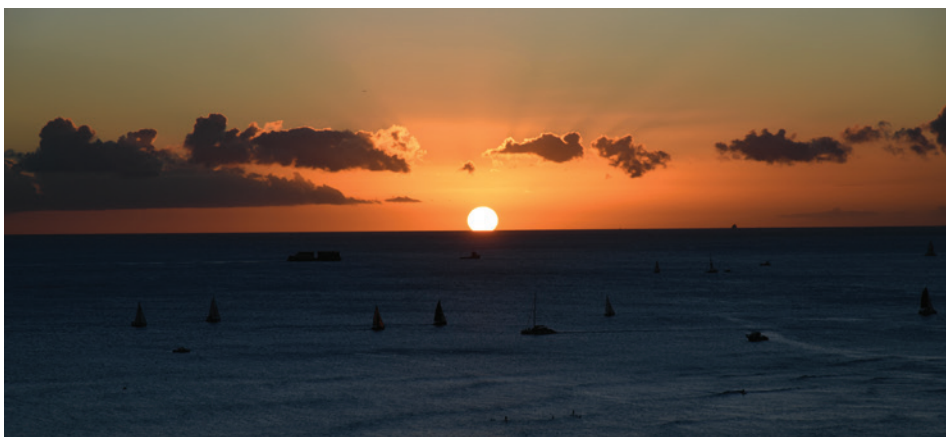
